Feeding Instructions

Add to daily feed ration, ideally feed prior to the onset of wet, muddy conditions for best results.

Horses & Ponies Loading rate	g per day	scoops per day
(7-14 days)*	69	3
Maintenance	23-46	1-2

^{*} Repeat the loading rate as required. Introduce gradually for fussy feeders.

One 50ml scoop provides approx. 23q. A 2.1kg pot fed at 23g per day will last approximately 90 days.

Maintenance levels may be adjusted to suit the individual and are not necessarily related to bodyweight.
