

# in the Pink Senior

## Feeding Instructions

Add to daily feed when the diet of the older horse needs balancing with micronutrients. Includes key gut, joint and herbal support to maintain condition, mobility, vitality and 'spark' in older horses and ponies.

Feed concentrated level at times of peak requirement, i.e. poor condition, regular travel.

One 15ml scoop provides approx. 10g. A 1.8kg pot fed at 30g per day will last approximately 60 days.

Wheat feed, Brewers' yeast, Maize, Calcium carbonate, Ginseng (Siberian), Glucosamine, Methyl sulphanyl methane, Gingko leaves, Dicalcium phosphate, Rapeseed oil, Whey protein powder, Sodium chloride, Rosehip shells, Carrot (dried), Fructo-oligosaccharides, Whey powder, Wheat protein, Beetroot juice, Maltodextrin, Magnesium oxide.
